
STEP-BY-STEP GUIDANCE



CHECK TRAVEL BOLTS


Prepare the doors following the decommissioning instructions particularly ensuring that **Travel Bolts** and packers are correctly fitted between the door and frame, (not on the outside of frame).

Do not stack Tempus doors on top of each other, the weight can easily bend doors.



PREPARE STILLAGE FOR LOADING

For convenience the **Bracing Arms** can be removed while loading but must be in place during loading, moving and slinging operations.



ORGANISE DOOR HANDING

To ensure that **Handles do not clash** (as shown) it is important to separate Left-handed doors from Right-handed.

For handing of Tempus, stand in the door frame with your back to the hinges and handing is the direction the door swings.




LIFT DOORS ONTO STILLAGE

Doors should always be loaded as shown:

- > Hinges down with handles at the top
- > Load onto stillage bottom of door first
- > Left Hand doors on one side (LH)
- > Right Hand doors on the other (RH)

Once the doors are loaded the **Bracing Arms** can be replaced if the were removed for loading.



SECURE WITH STRAPS

The supplied **Straps** are to be secured around the doors as shown to prevent them sliding.

They should be tight but **do not over-tighten** as it can deform or twist the doors.
